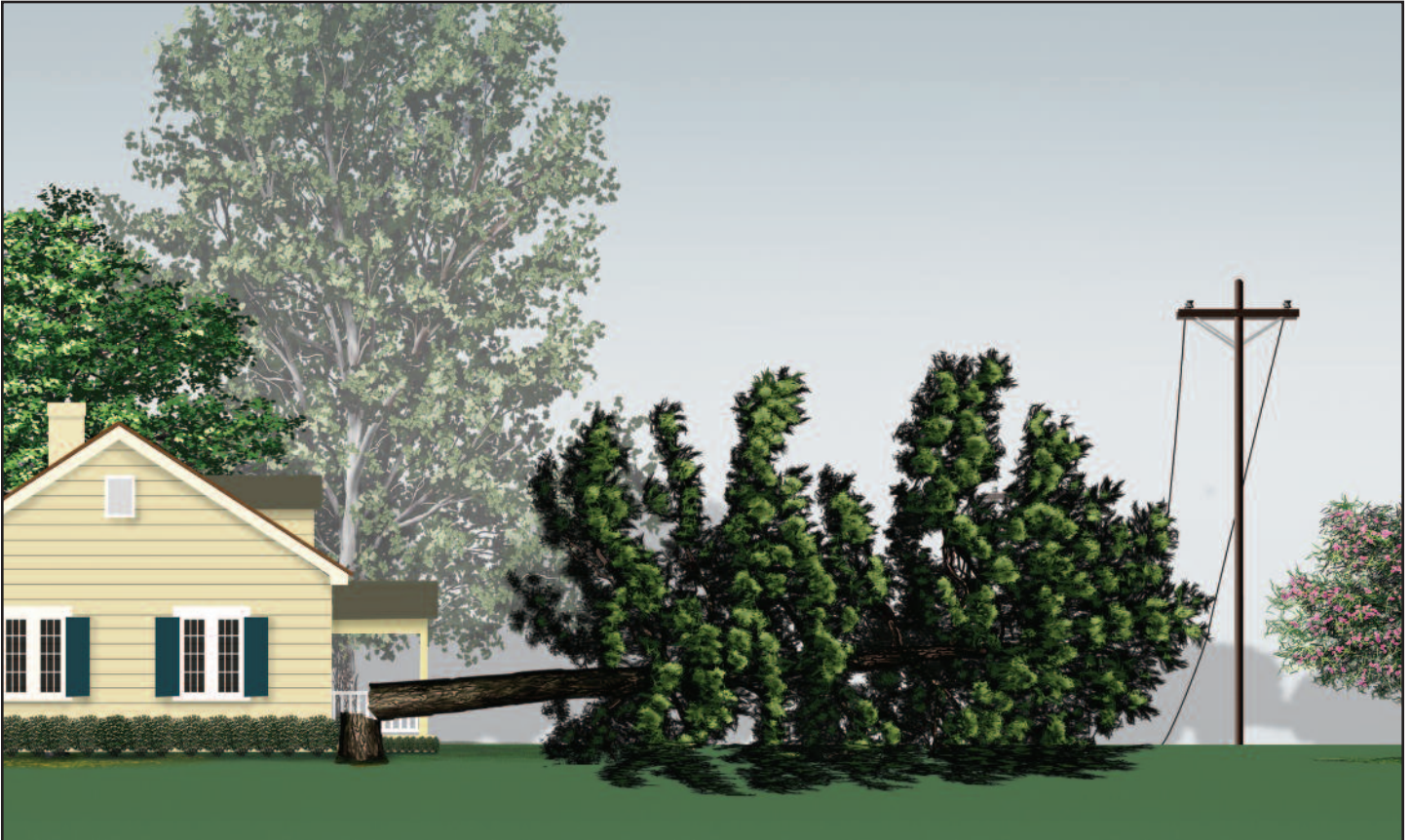


Cutting Trees to Create Defensible Space?
